Amateo's 7th International Conference On culture and cultural practices will be held in Stockholm on the theme *Culture, Health and Wellbeing* in Stockholm 2014. The host for the arrangement is The Swedish Amateur Culture Council (Amatörkulturens samrådsgrupp - ax).

The conference has a focus on Culture in Europe and provides a meeting place for cultural practioners, cultural organizations, and cultural researchers within Amateo's member countries. The key-note speakers will introduce different research areas: *Culture in relation to happiness, Culture in relation to the life situation of elderly people, and Culture in relation to social inclusion.*

During the conference contemporary research in the field of Culture, Health, and Well-being will be presented from the national, Nordic, and European perspectives. The participant's experiences and reflections concerning practice and research on the theme of the conference will be updated in small group discussions in connection with lectures and presentations.

The conference will be held in connection with Amateo's General Assembly Meeting 2014, with the agenda of Culture in relation to European politics, research and networking.

Key note speakers: Pablo Diego Rosell, will preliminary give a keynote lecture on the Gallup Wellbeing Index and where culture and the role of the amateur arts fit in to the picture.

Dr. Jeroen Lutters will give a keynote lecture on lifelong learning, happiness, elderly and inclusion. He is an expert in Lifelong learning and art based learning, and works as Professor/Lector in Art Education at Windesheim University and Artez institute of Arts.
